



Pupil Achievement 2016-2017

Key stage 2

- **67%** of our pupils met national expectations in **Reading**
- **23%** of our pupils achieved the **higher standard** in **Reading**
- **75%** of our pupils met national expectations in **Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling**
- **22%** of our pupils achieved the **higher standard** in **Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling**
- **68%** of our pupils met national expectations in **Writing**
- **13%** of our pupils achieved the **higher standard** in **Writing**
- **65%** of our pupils met national expectations in **Maths**
- **17%** of our pupils achieved the **higher standard** in **Maths**
- **50%** of our pupils met national expectations in **Reading, Writing and Maths combined**
- **10%** of our pupils achieved **the higher standard in all Reading, Writing and Maths combined**
- Average Points Progress Scores in **Reading + 0.6**
- Average Points progress Scores in **Writing – 0.5**
- Average Points Progress Scores in **Maths -0.4**

Key Stage 1

- **78%** of our pupils met national expectations in **Reading**
- **22%** of our pupils achieved **the higher standard** in **Reading**
- **66%** of our pupils met national expectations in **Writing**
- **12%** of our pupils achieved **the higher standard** in **Writing**
- **70%** of our pupils met national expectations in **Maths**
- **12%** of our pupils achieved **d the higher standard** in **Maths**
- **66%** of our pupils met national expectations in **Reading, Writing and Maths combined**
- **5%** of our pupils achieved **the higher standard in all Reading, Writing and Maths combined**
- **82%** of our pupils met or exceeded national expectations in phonics at the end of year 1

Early Years Foundation Stage

- **63%** of our pupils achieved their Good Level of Development (GLD)
- **88%** of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading
- **77%** of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Writing
- **85%** of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Number
- **95%** of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Maths
