



## Pupil Premium 2019-2020

This report details how Estcots Primary School will use the Pupil Premium allocation during the period April 2019 to March 2020. The schools allocation of Pupil Premium for this period is **£26,400**

As detailed in our Pupil Premium Policy the Governors reserve the right to allocate the funding to support any child or groups of children that the school has identified as needing additional support to achieve improving outcomes in learning and or well being.

The table below sets out the range and cost of interventions, in part funded by Pupil Premium during this period. The Pupil Premium Funding is used in a variety of ways to help overcoming barriers to learning. It is used to support intervention programmes and is also spent by the school to support children's learning and well being.

For 2019-2020 the money is allocated as follows:

Resources for Learning Mentor including equipment and resources for lunchtimes	To provide good equipment to ensure that the children are engaged and to promote good behavior at lunchtimes	£1,500
Resources for the classrooms	To ensure that all children and access to good quality equipment and resources to aid and assist with their learning	£2,500
Small group intervention – TA support	TA support in small group to close gaps and raise attainment	£15,383
Payment for residential trip for Year 6 Pupil Premium Children	To ensure that all children are able to attend the residential trip ensuring confidence, team building and independence from being away from home	£1,090
